Spiritual Direction

In spiritual direction, the director assists the directee to discern the various forces that seem to beckon in different directions. It is assumed that the "real" director is the Holy Spirit manifest in the relationship in a graced way.

The Spirit-Empowered Life - Ignatius of Loyola

One of the great masterpieces of the contemplative tradition, the spiritual exercises of Ignatius of Loyola offer guidance in discerning God's movement in your life, the circumstances in which you are most fully alive to God, and how you might best serve Christ in the world. Ignatian exercises according to the 19th annotation and Lightworks are offered.

Pastors have the option of making an individual pilgrimage through the exercises with a spiritual director or joining an Ignatian group with other pastors that is complimented monthly by individual spiritual direction.

Church members have the opportunity to join an Ignatian group and receive monthly individual spiritual direction.
