IN TIMES OF DISCONTINUOUS CHANGE

More and more of our pastors are commenting that technical solutions are not bringing about the significant kind of change needed in the church today. Simply working longer and harder at what we already know how to do will not help. We have to learn to minister differently. We need to develop new ministry leadership skills that we currently don't have. We were trained to lead in times of continuous change, but now we live in a world of discontinuous change. We need the Lord's help as we walk by faith and not by sight and try to lead our congregations where none of us have been before. This is hard work, but there are many encouraging signs. Mark and Alan will present in a conversational setting about what we are learning in terms of leadership shifts that will help our congregations move forward in positive ways. They will invite pastors into an ongoing action learning process for the coming year, that will grow their congregational leadership skills.
