



Tustin Presbyterian Church is seeking two part-time Church Musicians to lead our vital Ministry of Music---An Organist and a Chancel Choir Director.

Tustin Presbyterian Church has a strong choral tradition that is central to our vibrant, Reformed worship. A 53-rank Wicks/Schweitzer organ was installed in 1984 with upgrades in 1998 and 2006-2007. Our Chancel Choir enjoys the year-round presence of four professional section leaders. Our pastors preach from the Revised Common Lectionary and we celebrate the seasons of the liturgical year. We draw from the *Book of Common Worship* and other resources. Our worshipping community enjoys a wide range of hymnody and congregational song.

We are looking for musicians with classical training who will be at home in our church family. Our congregation loves to sing and our faith is renewed by anthems, motets, spirituals, chants and global songs. We currently use the *Presbyterian Hymnal* (1990) and *Sing the Faith*. Our choir rehearses on Thursday evenings and sings each Sunday (from September through June) at 9:30 am. We celebrate communion twice a month and in recent years have joined together in these extra occasions:

- Ash Wednesday Communion
- Maundy Thursday Communion
- Community Good Friday Service
- Easter Vigil
- Thanksgiving Eve Communion
- Spring Concert
- Christmas Concert
- Christmas Eve Lessons and Carols
- Seasonal Evensong

A selection of major works includes: Faure *Requiem*, Mozart *Requiem*, Bach *Magnificat*, Andrew Carter *California Canticles*, Rutter *Gloria*, Pinkham *Christmas Cantata*, Schubert *Mass in G*, Vivaldi *Gloria*, Britten, *Ceremony of Carols*
